ALAR Association is currently seeking up to five new volunteer Associate Editors (AEs) for the [*Action Learning and Action Research Journal*](#).

Responsibilities of AEs include:

- Soliciting the submission of high-quality contributions to the journal, commissioning papers and special issues (after gaining approval), etc.
- Handling the independent peer review and make publication recommendations
- Promoting the journal through academic and practice networks when applicable
- Participating in discussions involving journal policies and wider journal strategy.

Candidates will need to:

- be active in the Action Learning / Action Research field
- have confidence to engage with authors and reviewers to ensure that submissions are timely handled

The term of appointment will be two years, renewable at expiry, but subject to six-monthly reports indicating actions taken and papers' progress.

Interested candidates are welcome to submit their CV and a short letter indicating:

- academic and professional background
- any previous authoring, editorial or reviewing experience
- interest and involvement in Action Learning / Action Research
- area(s) of specialisation other than Action Learning / Action Research (education, human resources, sociology, management, etc.)
- ways in which the candidate would work with authors and reviewers to maximise publishable papers
